I am going to visit Hexham Old Gaol



When I arrive, I will see an open door. I can access this by going up the steps in front of me, or by using the ramp to my left

When I am inside, a Customer Host will serve me and give me my ticket at the desk on my left. I will also see the gift shop area





There are models of people in some of the rooms, but they do not move

There is one in the Dodd Room that shows how stocks were used.

In the lift, I can choose which floor to go to first. The “D” button will take me down to the dungeon



The lift doors do not open when I am in the dungeon, but I can view it from inside the lift. An audio track will play while I am in there.



I can then go up to the first floor by pressing the "1" button.



When I go in the Fenwick Room, a model of Sir Robert Carey will start talking to me about who he was and what his job was

On the second floor, I can enter the Milburn Room on my left.

I will see a family display. I can learn more about them by pressing the buttons on the board in front of them and listening to their stories



When I go into the Robson Room, I will see some brass rubbing equipment, dressing up clothes, colouring sheets and a Mini Museum trolley.

I am welcome to try all these activities.
